In a game with 13 lead changes and seven ties, Charleston edged Georgia State, 72-66, in the season opener before 2,512 fans Saturday at the Georgia State Sports Arena.

Georgia State led 39-35 at the half, but Charleston used 11 offensive rebounds in the second half to mount its comeback. State's 6-9 center Deven Dickerson played just five minutes due to an asthma attack and 6-8 backup Justin Billingslea was also unavailable. So, that left 6-8 Lance Perique and 6-7 Rashad Chase to battle the five Charleston big men.

Georgia State was led in scoring by Perique with 19 points, a personal best by one point, and he also led the team with seven rebounds. The Panthers shot 48 percent in the first half, but just 38.5 in the second to finish at 44 percent for the game. State shot well outside the arc with 7-of-14 three-point attempts made. Charleston shot 42 percent for the game and got 30 points in the paint.

In the second half, State built its largest lead of the game at 42-37 on a trey by Leonard Mendez before a 7-0 run by Charleston wiped that out at 44-42 with 16:54. State answered with five points and held a 47-44 advantage at the 16-minute mark and still led 51-48 at 13:20. Then, Charleston used its inside game to run off an 8-1 spurt and gain a 59-52 advantage with eight minutes left. State rallied to 66-63 with 1:11 as Trae Goldston made one of two free throws. Charleston was able to knock down 6-of-8 free throws in the final 42 seconds to earn the win.

A hot-shooting Georgia Tech squad ranked No. 21 in the nation defeated Georgia State 103-74 before 9,191 at Alexander Memorial Coliseum.

Georgia State shot 43 percent for the game but just 4-of-14 outside the arc (28.6 percent).

The game started with Georgia State opening an 8-5 margin over the first four minutes. Georgia Tech used a full-court defense and sharp outside shooting to go on a 19-0 run in a four-minute span in which it made four three-point baskets to open a 24-8 lead at 12:08.

When State closed to 28-15 at 9:32, Tech had another 13-5 run to get the lead to 21 points at 41-20 en route to a halftime lead of 58-30.

In that first half, Tech shot 61 percent with 8-of-13 outside the arc. Georgia State shot 40 percent on 10-25 but was hurt by 15 first half turnovers.

In the second half, Tech outscored State by just one point, 45-44. Eleven of the 12 players dressed out for the Panthers saw action, including walk-ons Ousman Krubally and Michael Moynihan, Lefty Driesell's grandson who played against his cousin, Tech's Ty Anderson. Starting center Deven Dickerson (6-9, 260) did not dress (asthma) and 6-8, 235-pound forward Justin Billingslea won't be eligible until December.

Sophomore Rashard Chase had career highs of 24 points and 11 rebounds and Georgia State scored 57 points in the second half as the Panthers rolled to a 94-87 victory over Winston-Salem State at the Georgia State Sports Arena.

The hosts trailed by five points at the half, but finished strong by shooting 61.5 percent in the second half to notch the first win of the season.

In the second half, the Rams held a 51-42 advantage with 16:39 to play. State immediately went on a 12-2 run to gain a 54-53 margin with 11:08 to play. But, Winston-Salem knocked down two more treys to give the Rams a 68-61 margin. Georgia State got a basket by Chase, followed by three's from Goldston and Mendez and it was back ahead, 69-68 at 5:25. A baseline jumper by Mendez gave State the lead for good at 71-70 with 4:26 to go and State would move on to the victory.

Georgia State had four players in double figures, led by Rashad Chase with 24 points, 18 of those in the second half, and 11 rebounds. Freshman guard Trae Goldston provided the outside spark with 22 points that included four-of-six three-point baskets. Guard Leonard Mendez produced 19 points with three-of-six three-point baskets.

Georgia State won for a 21st straight time when it tops 80 points and has won 55 of its last 58 when scoring 80 or more points. Georgia State hit 31-of-43 free throws, tying for the 10th-most made in a game in school history.

Georgia State battled back from a double-digit deficit to take a 63-62 lead with 3:45 to go, but host Charlotte finished with free throws to earn a 72-63 win Saturday night.

Charlotte was held 10 minutes without a field goal (13:00 to 2:42) as State battled back that 52-42 deficit to take the lead. But, Charlotte scored 16 of its final 20 points in the game from the line and shot 19-of-21 free throws in the second half to 5-of-6 free throws for Georgia State in the second half.

State (2-3) saw a two-game win streak end. Leading scorer Lance Perique was saddled with fouls and played just eight minutes of the first half, but came back strong to score 12 points (eight in the final 6:30 of the game). Georgia State made 10-of-24 baskets outside the three-point line.

Georgia State had battled back to take the lead behind three three-pointers from Ryan McBride and eight of 10 points from Perique during a 20-9 run.

The game started with Georgia making four of its first five shots to open a quick 10-5 at 16:45. Host Charlotte then went on a 16-1 run with a trio of three-point baskets sparking the run that gave the home team a 21-11 advantage at 8:52. The teams traded baskets and Charlotte still held a 33-20 lead at 4:30 when State came charging back as Perique played four more minutes. State finished with a 10-2 run to close to 35-30 at the halftime.

Rashad Chase had a double-double for State with 13 points and a personal best 12 rebounds.

Scrappy State closed to within five points twice during the final three minutes at 51-46 with 3:48 and 53-48 with 2:15. Drexel made 7-of-9 free throws in the final two minutes to win its eighth straight game and improve to 10-2 overall and 2-0 in the CAA.

Georgia State's starting wing Brandon Cartwright, a 6-5 senior, suffered a broken bone in his hand in yesterday's practice, and team captain and starting guard Leonard Mendez was suffering from a severe case of the flu that had sent him to the emergency room. Reserve forward Wesley Turner was already sidelined with a broken nose sustained two games ago.

The Panthers kept closing the margin as State shot 52.4 percent in the second half, hit 13-of-17 free throws and had just seven turnovers. But Drexel's offensive rebounds and free throws enabled the Dragons to claim the win, their fifth road victory of the season. Drexel scored 30 of its 61 points in the paint to State's 16, but the Panthers scored 20 points off of Drexel's turnovers, compared to 13 points off turnovers for the Dragons.

In pre-game ceremonies, Georgia State retired the No. 5 jersey of All-American forward Thomas Terrell, a key member of the 2001 29-5 NCAA Final 32 team and the 20-11 postseason NIT team. Terrell was back in the states during a break from his European league team, where he is a two-time league Most Valuable Player.

Georgia State posted its first CAA win of the year with a dramatic come-from-behind 87-81 double overtime win over Towson.

Trailing by six points with five minutes to play, the Panthers (5-8/1-2) tied the game at 64 with 11 seconds left on a three-point basket from the corner by forward Rashad Chase.

In the first overtime, State led by three after a trey by Lance Perique with 1:39. but Tim Crossin hit a free throw and Gary Neal a basket with 24 seconds left to tie that period at 72.

In the second overtime, Lance Perique made two free throws, then stole a pass and drove for a tomahawk dunk to put State up four in the first minute. Towson pulled with one at 80-79 with 1:57 to go on a trey by Rocky Coleman. An offensive rebound by Chase and two free throws put State up three. With 30 seconds left, Chase hit a final three to provide the victory for the Panthers.

Georgia State got double-doubles from their forwards Perique and Chase. The 6-8 Perique had 26 points and a career-best 14 rebounds. The 6-7 Chase had 23 points and had 12 rebounds for his third double-double of the year.

Georgia State had a season-best 11 three-point baskets, one more than in the opener vs. Charleston. The 50 rebounds are also a season best for State.

State has now won 22 consecutive games when scoring 80 or more points and 56 of the past 59 games when they are able to top the 80-point total.

Georgia State saw Northeastern stage a second-half rally to post a 84-69 win in a Colonial Athletic Association game at Matthews Arena.

Georgia State's strong first half and 61 percent shooting gave them a 45-31 lead at the break. But the Huskies seemingly could not miss in the second half as they made 9-of-their-first 12 shots, including four three-pointers, to go on a 25-5 spurt and gain a 56-50 advantage with 11:35 to play.

Georgia State closed to within 58-56 with 8:40 to play after a three-point basket by Leonard Mendez. With a 61-58 lead, Northeastern's Bobby Kelly hit another three to spark a 68-58 NU lead. Georgia State won its second straight CAA road game, a first in its short league history, with a 61-44 win at Delaware at Bob Carpenter Center in front of 2,731.

The Panthers have now won three of the past five CAA games to move into a tie for sixth place in the 12-team league. They led by six at the half and never let Delaware any closer. Georgia State held Delaware to 27 percent shooting overall and 14 percent outside the three-point arc.

State (7-10, 3-4) grew a six-point halftime lead to double figures at 48-37 at 8:06 and kept it in double figures the rest of the way. Forward Lance Perique led State with 19 points, while sophomore forward Rashad Chase had his fifth double-double of the season with 12 points and a career-best 15 rebounds.

Georgia State built its six-point halftime lead to 38-28 at 14:31 with a pair of second-chance baskets. Delaware's challenge closed the game to 39-33 at 12:06, but Chase and Perique got the lead back to 10 at 10:24. When Delaware closed back to six for the final time at 43-37 at 9:33, Ron Larris answered with a trey from the corner, Chase scored in the paint and Mendez stole and pass and drove for a lay-up to make it 50-37 at 7:35.

The Panthers hit eight of their first 11 shots in opening a 16-7 lead at 12:26 with Perique scoring eight of those 16 points. A free throw by Rashad Chase at 11:58 gave State its largest first half lead of 10 points at 17-7. A three-point basket by Leonard Mendez and two free throws by Perique gave State a 29-23 halftime lead. Perique scored 14 of State's 29 first-half points.

CAA foes Georgia State and James Madison battled to the finish before the visiting Dukes escaped with a 59-52 decision Saturday night at the Georgia State Sports Arena.

Georgia State (7-11, 3-5) was using its outside shooting while James Madison (6-12, 3-5) was relying on its inside rebounding as the teams traded momentum. JMU led 37-31 with 13 minutes to play when a trey by Ryan McBride pulled the Panthers within three. The Dukes then opened a nine-point margin at 43-34 at 10:58, but State came charging right back to make it 47-44 at 6:24 after treys from Ron Larris and McBride. JMU scored more inside to open a 54-47 advantage with 2:41 to play, but State answered with its ninth three-pointer of the game to close to 55-51 with 22 seconds on the clock.

Just when it looked like JMU would secure the win with a pair of free throws at 17.9 seconds to make it 57-51, State followed with an offensive rebound and James Madison was called for a foul and a technical foul. But, Leonard Mendez made just one of the two technical free throws and Lance Perique missed the front end of his one-and-one free throw chances. Terrance Carter made two free throws with 2.5 seconds to seal the second straight win for JMU and end a two-game Georgia State winning streak.

Georgia State made 9-of-21 three-point attempts and shot a solid 47.4 percent for the game, but just 50 percent from the free throw line. Georgia State felt it had an inside advantage against Hofstra, but the visiting Pride answered with outside accuracy to pull away at the end for a 76-63 win on Wednesday night at the Sports Arena.

Georgia State dropped a 92-57 Colonial Athletic Association game at Old Dominion before 5,772 at the Constant Convocation Center.

The Panthers (7-14, 3-8) were led in scoring by Lance Perique with 16 points, Brandon Cartwright with 12 points and eight rebounds and Leonard Mendez with 11 points. Deven Dickerson led with nine rebounds and two blocks. Old Dominion (15-7, 8-3) won its third straight game and has not lost a CAA home game this season.

The Monarchs shot 51 percent for the game with nine three-point baskets as they grew a 16-point halftime margin to 20 points at the 14-minute mark and never let the Panthers get any closer.

Lance Perique had 19 points and seven rebounds and Georgia State gained its first-ever season series sweep with a 72-60 win over Colonial Athletic Association rival UNC Wilmington Wednesday at the Georgia State Sports Arena.

Georgia State (8-14, 4-8) had four players in double figures on offense and limited the UNC Wilmington (5-16, 2-10) to 32.8 percent shooting for the game and just 25.9 percent outside the arc. Wilmington was last year's tournament champion and NCAA bid winner.

The Panthers got 15 points each from guards Leonard Mendez and Trae Goldston, while Brandon Cartwright added 12 points, four rebounds and three assists before getting into second-half foul trouble. Goldston hit 4-of-6 three-point baskets and Mendez reached double figures for a 12th straight game.

State kept control and was leading 57-46 with 3:10 to play when the Seahawks made one final push. A Kuljanin three-point play closed the score to 61-57 with just 1:07 left. But, State made its free throws down the stretch to re-open the double digit lead.

Georgia State went on the road to VCU and came home with a 100-71 loss to the Colonial Athletic Association-leading Rams at Alltel Pavilion at Stuart Siegel Center.

Georgia State dropped a 92-65 decision to Towson in a Colonial Athletic Association Saturday afternoon game at Towson Center.

Towson (13-13, 7-8) got an outstanding performance from the No. 6 scorer in the nation, Gary Neal, as he topped his 25.4 average with 37 points on 8-of-13 three-point shooting and 13-of-20 overall.

Towson rolled early to a 50-31 halftime lead and Georgia State got no closer than 60-44 at 12:32 as the Tigers then continued to build the lead down the stretch.

In the first half, Towson made its first five shots, including three three-point baskets by Gary Neal and a three-point shot by Pease, to open a 16-7 lead at 15:30. But, Georgia State put on a run of its own with a 10-2 burst to close to 20-19 at 10:30. At that point, Georgia State was 10-of-12 from the field. But, the Gary Neal show continued with a free throw, an old-fashioned three-point play, a driving basket for six straight point to start a 10-0 Towson run to open a 32-21 lead at 6:31. Neal continued his onslaught with eight straight points again and Towson had a 40-24 lead at 4:23. In the final two minutes, Neal made his fifth trey of the half and another basket to close the first half with 28 points on 10-of-13 shooting for 28 points. Georgia State shot 65 percent in the first half on 13-of-20, but was just 3-of-13 from the free throw line.

Georgia State shot 54 percent in the second half en route to earning a 71-65 CAA win over Northeastern Wednesday at the Georgia State Sports Arena.

The Panthers went on a 9-0 run to go from one down at 49-48 with 6:08 to up 57-49 with 3:45 left. Then, State calmly made all eight of its free throws in the final minute to secure its first ever win over Northeastern. During the 9-0 run, Ron Larris made a three-point basket, Leonard Mendez was fouled shooting a three and made three free throws and Ryan McBride made a 25-foot trey with the shot clock running out.

Georgia State (9-17, 5-11) got a personal-best 21 points from sophomore guard Mendez and 19 points from forward Lance Perique on 8-of-11 shooting. State shot 84 percent from the free throw line with 16-of-19 made. Each team had 32 rebounds.

Northeastern (9-18, 7-9) had its two-game win streak ended, but not without a fight. The visiting Huskies hit 12-of-25 three-point shots and had closed a 10-point lead down to just two points with 8.2 seconds left after that 12th trey.

The game included nine lead changes and four ties. Georgia State led by five twice in the first half, but Northeastern came back to lead by seven and take a one-point lead into halftime, 29-28. Thus, this marked the Panthers fifth win of the year after trailing at halftime.

In the second half, Northeastern had an 8-0 run to open a 37-30 lead. But Mendez sparked a run to bring State back to a 37 tie at 14:46. The teams traded the lead until Georgia State seized it for good in its run at the six-minute mark.

Georgia State used solid defense to post a 63-53 ESPN BracketBuster victory over Elon.

The Panthers (10-17, 5-11) posted their second straight win behind a career-high 22 points from Leonard Mendez, who scored 21 points one game earlier against Northeastern. Junior forward Justin Billingslea pulled down a personal-best 12 rebounds, and senior forward Lance Perique added 12 points. Georgia State held a 41-32 rebound advantage with 15 offensive boards in front of its Homecoming and Letterwinners Day crowd of 1,205.

Elon (6-20, 4-11) of the Southern Conference was led in scoring by senior forward Chris Chalko and freshman guard Devan Carter with 12 points each. Senior LeVonn Jordan topped the Phoenix with nine rebounds but scored just five points, ten below his average.

Georgia State grew a 25-22 halftime lead to 41-30 at the 10-minute mark and it appeared the host Panthers were in control. But, the visitors went on a 12-5 run to close back to 46-42 with 4:56 to play with Chalko getting five points, including a trey.

The final push by Georgia State then grew a 48-44 lead into a 55-44 advantage after a pair of free throws by Perique, a trey from the corner by guard Ron Larris, and a steal that led to a dunk by Perique with 1:20 to play. This was State's first ESPN BracketBuster win after an 83-75 loss last year at Charleston.

Georgia State blocked a season-best seven shots with three by Deven Dickerson. The Panthers held Elon to 38.5 percent shooting in holding its ninth opponent to under 60 points this season. The 53 points allowed were the second lowest of the year.

Georgia State and VCU were tied less than three minutes to play before the Rams escaped with a 72-70 victory to clinch the Colonial Athletic Association regular-season title.

The Rams were clinging to a 68-67 lead when forward Michael Anderson was fouled with four seconds left. He made the front end of the one-and-one, but missed the second. Jesse Pellot-Rosa grabbed the rebound, scored and got fouled with three seconds remaining. He made the free throw to give the Rams a 72-67 advantage. Leonard Mendez nailed a three-pointer at the buzzer for the Panthers to make the final score 72-70.

With 2:30 to play, Georgia State tied the score at 61 on a driving layup by point guard Ron Larris. VCU regained the lead for good on a pair of free throws by Eric Maynor and a basket by Wil Fameni.

A bucket by Brandon Cartwright pulled the Panthers within three at 68-65 with 26 seconds left. Maynor's missed free throw with 23.9 seconds to play gave the Panthers a chance to tie with a three-pointer, but VCU fouled Mendez, who made both shots to make the score 68-67 with 9.8 seconds left.

Mendez led the Panthers with 28 points, his career best. Deven Dickerson had 14 points, seven rebounds and three blocked shots, and Lance Perique added 13 points for Georgia State.

State never trailed in the first half, leading by as many as 13 points. The Panthers jumped out to a 19-6 lead in the game's first eight minutes. Dickerson and Mendez each had six points during the flurry. The Rams responded with a 15-2 run to tie the score at 21-21 with 4:35 remaining in the half, before GSU finished the half on a 7-3 run to take a 28-24 lead at intermission.

Leonard Mendez hit a 33-foot three-pointer at the buzzer to lift ninth-seeded Georgia State to a 70-68 victory over eighth-seeded William & Mary in the first round of the Colonial Athletic Association Tournament in Richmond, Va.

The Panthers (11-19) won a game in the CAA Tournament for the second straight year and for the ninth time in their last 10 conference tournaments.

Georgia State led by 10 with four minutes to play before William & Mary used an 11-2 run to pull within two points, 67-65, on a three-pointer by Nathan Mann with 26 seconds left. After Ryan McBride missed free throw, the Tribe tied the score on a layup by Adam Payton, who was fouled. Payton completed the three-point play to put William & Mary up 68-67 with just five seconds left.

After a timeout, Mendez dribbled across halfcourt and, despite a double-team, put up the 33-foot shot from the left side of the court. After the ball swished through the nets, the Panthers celebrated while the officials confirmed that the shot had beaten the buzzer.

Payton's free throw had given the Tribe its first lead since 6-5 early in the first half. A layup by Rashad Chase with 10 minutes left in the period broke a 10-10 tie as the Panthers outscored the Tribe 19-9 to build a 29-19 advantage at the intermission. State led by as many as 13 in the second half, building a 54-41 lead on Lance Perique's three-point play with 10 minutes to play.

Mendez, a sophomore who led the CAA in threepoint shooting percentage, turned in an outstanding game with 17 points, seven rebounds, four assists, four steals and two blocked shots. Four Panthers scored in double figures as Perique contributed 15 points, McBride scored 14, including four treys, and Chase added 13 points. State hit 11-of-19 three-pointers and shot 52 percent overall from the field, including 68 percent (15-of-22) in the second half.

For the second time in a week, Georgia State played a close game against top-seeded VCU, but the Rams earned a 73-60 victory in the quarterfinals of the CAA Tournament, ending the Panthers season.

Georgia State trailed by 10 points at the half, 43-33, but opened the second half with a 12-2 run to close to 48-45 at 13:40. Sophomore Leonard Mendez, who scored a game-high 22 points, keyed the run with two three-pointers and a layup.

But the top-seeded Rams answered with a 12-0 run to lead 60-45 with seven minutes left. Georgia State, hurt by 20 turnovers, could get no closer than 10 the rest of the way.

State was led by Mendez, whose 22 points included 6-of-11 three-point baskets, while senior Lance Perique added 15 points in his final game. The Panthers (11-20) hit 8-of-19 outside the three-point arc.

Richmond native Deven Dickerson, who played only six minutes in the first half after picking up two fouls, had a strong second half en route to a double-double with 13 points and 10 rebounds. "We played hard today but we made some key mistakes," said Dickerson. "They are No. 1 in the league for a reason, but we challenged them hard."

In last week's game, Georgia State jumped to the early lead, but in this contest, the Rams had the hot start, opening the game with an 18-4 spurt in the first seven minutes. VCU extended its lead to 27-11 with 7:39 left in the half before the Panthers used an 11-2 run to pull within 29-22. VCU led by 10 at the intermission at 43-33.
